“Energy for Transition: PNRR, green revolution and ecological transition for the future of the country”

The European device for recovery and resilience provides for Italy to disburse € 191.5 billion in grants and loans for the period 2021-2026. Further € 30.6 billion are added to these, part of a complementary fund and € 13 billion made available by REACT-EU.

The total resources foreseen in the Italian PNRR is therefore equal to € 235.1 billion.

Among the 6 Missions identified by the Plan, the "Green Revolution and Energy Transition" is of particular interest for the 2021 energy week also because it promotes themes that the Lombardy Region has anticipated as priorities for regional development; that is: the Protocol for Sustainable Development, with its ambitious goal of making Lombardy no longer just an economic engine but also a "sustainable locomotive" of Italy, and the Regional Energy, Environment and Climate Program (PREAC), which will design the stages of a path that will lead Lombardy to be a region with zero net emissions by 2050. In this "Energy Talk", accredited among the events of EUSEW (European Week of Sustainable Energy) we intend to decline the opportunities represented by the PNRR for companies with a high artisan value, promoting a comparison between the solicitations of the associative world of SMEs and the responses from the political-institutional world to put enterprises with a high artisan value in the conditions to seize these opportunities.
